MECHANICS:

- a. Any interested party, from the academe to the business sector, local or foreign group or individual, can conduct research on any of the topics on the attached list or share resources with our office for their realization, such as technical expertise, references, and funds.
- b. To prevent duplication of study, proposed sponsors are enjoined to coordinate with the Directorate for Program Development for topic reservation at tel. # 927-63-83 local 112;
- c. As a matter of security protocol, proposed researchers should secure the necessary clearance from the BJMP-National Headquarters before going to jails and interact with inmates for their protection and of the host unit.
- d. Upon completion of the study, the sponsor researchers shall furnish the BJMP a copy of the research report for use in program development.
- e. If sponsorship comes in material or financial contribution, such should pass through the normal machinery of the bureau for resource acquisition to uphold transparency and accountability.

PROGRAM PROMOTION:

Upon approval for implementation, this program will be posted in the BJMP website, to include the initial list of research topics.

Copies of the program package will be sent to proposed sponsors.
